Janet Naquin - she is in opposition of rezoning in this area and feels that it is currently zoned appropriately.

Gould - he promised the residents that this area would remain residential.

Gould - moved to concur with the denial, second by Thompson. Unanimous with 1 absent (Canulette).

Gould - moved to adopt a resolution, second by Thompson. Unanimous with 1 absent (Canulette); becomes Resolution C.S. No. C-2740.

2) Applicant Joy Burnett appealing the Zoning Commission DENIAL on October 6, 2009 of a conditional use permit for a 1,748 square foot Commercial Dog Kennel north of Eagle Road, west of South Fitzmorris Road, address 102 Eagle Road, Covington. (Ward 3, District 2) (CP09-10-080)

NOTE:

To concur with Zoning DENIAL, a simple majority vote is required and adoption of a resolution.

NOTE:

To override Zoning DENIAL, a majority vote of the entire Council is required and adoption of a resolution.

Joy Burnett - she no longer wants the commercial rezoning. She was led to believe that she needed a Conditional Use Permit in order to have her land rezoned commercial. She no longer wants the land to be rezoned commercial. She just wants to be able to keep at least four of the remaining dogs on her property. These dogs are owned by her and not adoptable. She is also asking for more time to move all of the other dogs out of the Parish.

John Miranda - he has lived on Eagle Road since 1983. They received a certified letter notifying them of this appeal. They do not want a commercial dog kennel in their area, but they do not want to deny Ms. Burnett her rights to keep her animals. The original deed to his house states that no animals were allowed to create a nuisance in the neighborhood. Three other commercial licenses have been denied in this area previously.

Bill Davis - his property abuts Ms. Burnett's. She has 23 animals and says that 9 of them are her personal pets. There is a lot of barking. If it is true that she is not trying to open a commercial kennel, then he is not against her keeping some of the dogs as pets. However, the current number that she has is outrageous.

Lloyd Garranginer - his property also abuts Ms. Burnett's. He appreciates her interest in maintaining some of the animals, but he is against her keeping all of the ones that are there. He asks that the council maintain the peace and harmony of the neighborhood by limiting the number of

animals she is allowed to keep.

Unidentified woman - wants to speak on behalf of Ms. Burnett. Ms. Burnett rescued most of these dogs after Hurricane Katrina. Ms. Burnett has had a lot of dogs for a while and has been making her best attempt to bring down the number that she keeps. Ms. Burnett just wants to keep 9 of the current dogs.

Cooper - Ms. Burnett - how many dogs do you have right now?

Burnett - 23.

Cooper - how much time do you need to move them? Did you know about the deed restrictions?

Burnett - she checked her deed through the Clerk of Court and it does not say anything about animals.

Cooper - there is an ad on the internet that states you will pet sit animals, including reptiles, in your home.

Burnett - that was her daughter who actually wants to pet sit in other people's homes.

Cooper - he wants to grant her 45 days to move all of the animals except for 5. He also wants to prohibit her from selling or buying any animals.

Stefancik - he can understand denying the appeal tonight, but can the Council restrict the number of animals she keeps?

Davis - there is an Ordinance that states that she can have 6 animals.

Sidney Fontenot - it states that on five acres or more, 6 animals are allowed.

Neil Hall - that is correct. She can keep 6 animals. If the Council concurs with the denial, then she is automatically limited to 6 animals. He is not sure if the Council can grant her 45 days to correct the situation.

Davis - the normal process would be to send out Code Enforcement, who would give her 10 days to correct the problem before they would cite them. Then she would have 30 days to correct it before she would have to appear in court. He thinks they can work with her to give her time to remove the animals.

Cooper - moved to concur with the denial, second by Thompson. Unanimous with 1 absent (Canulette).

Cooper - moved to adopt a resolution, second by Stefancik. Unanimous with 1 absent (Canulette); becomes Resolution C.S. No. C-2741.

Cooper - Mr. Hall can you clarify that the Highlands Homeowners Association has all of the information needed to proceed with this?

Hall - there are a total of 126 lots in this subdivision and the Parish has received written approval from 70 lot owners which is 55% of the Homeowners and that is all that is needed.

Cooper - he wants the Highlands Subdivision residents to know that he has a lot of roads in his district, and he is not promising to fix the roads right away. It will depend on how much money he has and how many other roads entered the system before this subdivision.

Cooper - moved to adopt, second by Artigue. Unanimous with 2 absent (Dean, Canulette); becomes Ordinance C.S. No. 09-2147.

Sevante - due to the merger of Fire Protection Districts 9 and 10, the appointments have changed. James Scott Leblanc will be appointed by Kevin Davis and Harvey Hayden will be appointed by Ms. Crawford-Howell. The Village of Sun will appoint two (2) members and then the four (4) board members will nominate a fifth member.

Crawford-Howell-moved to adopt, second by Cooper. Unanimous with 2 absent (Canulette, Billiot); becomes Resolution C.S. No. C-2743.

Binder - 3) Resolution to appoint Rosalie Boudreaux to replace Marc Guillory (resigned) to St. Tammany Parish Fire Protection District No. 2. (Dean)

Dean - moved to adopt, second by Thompson. Unanimous with 1 absent (Canulette).

Falconer - moved to open the Off-the-Floor Agenda, second by Crawford-Howell. Unanimous with 1 absent (Canulette).

OFF-THE-FLOOR

Binder - 1) Resolution to amend Ordinance C.S. 08-1968 - 2009-2013 Capital Improvement Budget and Program, Fixed Assets and Grant Awards. (Thompson)

Thompson - moved to adopt, second by Gould. Unanimous with 1 absent (Canulette); becomes Resolution C.S. No. C-2745.

Binder - 2)Resolution remanding and referring to the Zoning Commission for consideration of the Comprehensive Rezoning Designation for those properties identified on the South West Area Zoning Map within the area commonly referred to as the Covington Country Club and being designated, in part, as CB-1 Community Based Facilities District. (Ward 4, District 4) (Falconer)

Falconer - on August 28, 2009 a resubdivision was approved that created 8 smaller lots in this subdivision. Neither the Zoning Commission nor the Council were aware of this resubdivision at

the time the Comprehensive Rezoning for this area was adopted.

Falconer - moved to adopt, second by Gould. Unanimous with 1 absent (Canulette); becomes Resolution C.S. No. C-2746.

Binder - 4) Resolution approving the holding of a special emergency election in St. Tammany Parish Fire Protection District No. 5 on Saturday, December 26, 2009 to authorize the continuation of a special tax therein. (Thompson)

Falconer - he finds it distasteful for an election to be held the day after Christmas. How did the fire district find itself in this position?

Donald Hames - Chairman of the fire Board. The Fire District was not notified by the Assessor's office that the election needed to happen before the end of the year.

Chief Pittman - normally the fire district receives a notice from the Assessor that the tax is coming due and they need to put it out to a vote. However, ignorance is not an excuse. It was also an overlook on the part of the district.

Falconer - he understands that mistakes happen. The rezoning that the Council is doing is an example of that.

Pittman - they just received a letter from the Legislative Auditor's Office that listed all 69 taxing districts and stated all of the beginning dates and expiration dates of the millages for each body. The fire district board is comprised of lay people. They are not lawyers and did not know that an election needed to be held. In May, the district had to complete a paper to establish the millage rate. They never thought that it may be time for it to expire. The district has 2 millages both of which were rolled back. They receive about \$400,000 from those millages, and if they do not receive that money, then the fire district is sunk.

Gould - Chief Pittman is not just the Chief, but he attends all of the emergencies in the district. He does not have a lot of support staff.

Pittman - they are making a chart for the deadlines for both of the millages. The district serves 700 people and they are trying to expand the coverage. They have 5 full-time employees and several part-time. He is asking for this election for the people who they serve.

Grant Schlueter - the Assessor's office told him that if there was any way to hold a special emergency election before the end of the year, then they would file a supplemental tax bill to be sent out by the Sheriff. The Secretary of State said that they would have to meet all of the publication dates and that the last possible day to hold the election is December 26th because it has to be on a Saturday. They were just barely able to satisfy those requirements.

Binder - is it the role of the Assessor to notify the district?

Schlueter - she is not legally obligated, but thinks that they do it as a safeguard. The same thing has happened in parishes all across the state.

Davis - the Governor has not yet approved the election. His concern is that if the election is not approved is there a Plan B?

Schlueter - no, then the tax cannot be collected this year.

Davis - can they do interim borrowing?

Schlueter - they could and they will still receive the money from collection of the smaller millage.

Davis - thinks that the Council should adopt 2 other resolutions, one to give to the Governor and one to the State Treasurer encouraging them to approve the election.

Thompson - moved to adopt, second by Gould. Unanimous with 1 absent (Canulette); becomes Resolution C.S. No. C-2748.

Stefancik - moved to adopt a Resolution to be sent to the Governor requesting approval of the election, second by Burkhalter. Unanimous with 1 absent (Canulette); becomes Resolution C.S. No. C-2749.

Stefancik - moved to adopt a Resolution to be sent to the State Treasurer requesting approval of the election, second by Burkhalter. Unanimous with 1 absent (Canulette); becomes Resolution C.S. No. C-2750.

Binder - 3) Discussion - truck traffic at the intersection of Ben Thomas Road and U.S. Highway 11 in Slidell. (Burkhalter)

Burkhalter - this issue has been a thorn in his side for many years. In the last week alone, 3 trucks haven fallen into the ditch causing the shoulder to collapse while turning onto Highway 11. Mr. Davis offered the Parishes' help by widening the apron at this intersection, and the State Government is working on widening the highway. He would like for signs to be installed stating the trucks need to enter the road from Highway 190. All of the speed limit and weight limit signs have been knocked down.

Davis - he does not know if the Parish can legally install signs, but he does know that they can not enforce it.

Hall - Highway 11 is a State Highway and the Parish is not allowed to install signs on it. The most the Council can do is send a resolution to the Department of Transportation.

Council discussion ensued.

Burkhalter - moved to adopt a resolution to the Louisiana Department of Transportation urging them to install no turn signs, second by Stefancik. Unanimous with 3 absent (Dean, Gould, Canulette); becomes Resolution C.S. No. C-2747.

DISCUSSION

Davis - he wanted to give an update on Southeast Louisiana flood control plans. He had a meeting with the Federal government about the W14 Canal. The problem is that Congress has decided to revamp the Corp of Engineers and they have asked for all of the Corps' current projects to be reviewed, so now it may take another 18 months before any type of flood control is even started. He is drafting a letter to the government asking why the South Shore has \$14.5 billion to spend and the North Shore has none. The Corps' brochure of projects in South Louisiana does not mention the North Shore at all.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned at the call of the Chairman.
