Robert Bohne - he is a resident of District 4. This issue came to light when he and his children were swimming in a pool in their backyard when a drone flew over and began recording them. He followed the drone back to its owner and asked to see the video, which showed his 2 young daughters playing in their pool. The gentleman deleted the video. He asked David Ellis of Mandeville City Council what laws there were about drones, but there are none. He is concerned because what if a sex offender starts operating a drone.

Greg Gonzales - He is a lieutenant with the Sheriff's Office and was asked by the Sheriff to come. There are FAA regulations on flying drones, but there were no laws broken in this case. Currently, drones fall under the category of model aircraft, which have to be registered with the FAA, operator

must be over the age of 13, and the drone cannot be flown over a crowd. If a drone is being operated recklessly, the Sheriff can fine them, but right now, there is not much the local law enforcement can do. The FAA regulations can be found at FAA.gov.

O'Brien - read a statement from Cathy Foley with Recreation District 1 who discussing creation of a drone park. She wants to raise awareness to make sure everyone is respectful.

O'Brien - moved to adopt, second by Canulette. Unanimous with 1 absent (Lorino).

Stefancik - 18. Resolution C.S.
